Why

- Goal: Zero Cash Deficit no leaking of cash
 - Council wanted to be able to plan for any long term projects/issues and wanted to be financially diligent when making those decisions.
- Planning for services
 - Service planning mindset to look into the short, medium and long term impacts.
- Local Government Act legislative changes





How

- Funding
 - Finance and Accounting Support Team (FAST), perfect platform to use the resources of the FAST stream 1 funding program.
 - Stream 1 was an established panel of qualified and experienced finance and accounting professionals. The panel
 were to be used to assist to deliver co-designed packages to support rural council's.
 - Impact Consulting Group
- Principles
 - No rate cap variation
 - Zero cash deficit
 - New borrowings only considered for long-term infrastructure for multi-generational benefit
 - Low / Medium risk (VAGO indicators)
 - Maintain a level of own sourced expenditure on roads
 - Capital renewal expenditure aligned with Council's renewal needs
- Outputs
 - Models available to assist with our principles
 - IPWEA Institute of Public Works Engineering Australia
 - Towong
 - No service plan models identified





Implementation and integration

- Financial assistance panel
 - Impact Consulting Group, scoped, researched, planned and scheduled the works to be conducted.
- Council education
 - Key council staff involvement
 - Staff impacted by LTFP and Service plan
 - Councilor's briefed
- Integration Budget process and SRP
