Key Messages

High level



- Council's annual budget outlines how resources are prioritised to deliver important and relevant programs to the community.
- The draft budget also incorporates the major initiatives identified by the Council as priorities in the Council Plan 2021 -2015, to be undertaken during the next financial year.
- Council **would like** to **hear from residents** about what their **priorities** are as we prepare our draft budget.
- There is a **small potential** that approximately up to 3% of the overall budget may be available for **discretionary** spending.
- As part of our customer and community engagement, Council will implement a multi-phased approach that builds on our ongoing genuine engagement promise.
- Further **consultation** will be delivered throughout April and May.
- Council **aims** to approve the 2023/24 Budget at it's June meeting.


